- 5. Look at Jonah 3:10(a) and compare this with James 2:20. How is faith displayed? How did God know that the people had repented?
- 6. Discuss some "Ninevites" in your life that you would rather not take the Word to and why.

- 7. Discuss "Unwilling Obedience." (Read St. Luke 5:4-9)
- 8. How can obedience be both constructive and destructive? Does it depend on the object of your obedience?

SisStar Reflections

- 1. Although you cannot see the totality of God's plan, you can cooperate with that part which He requires of you.
- 2. Evil is always overcome by good and it is your choice which way you will take.
- 3. God always gives you another chance to obey His Word. He expects you to be a doer of what you hear and read.
- 4. When you are obedient to the Word, you may be the catalyst to someone else's salvation.
- 5. "Hearing" means to take heed and to act on what has been heard. You respond positively to what you have heard.
- 6. Your faith in the Word of God is seen by the way you obey and live what you have heard.
- 7. God has given you the Holy Spirit to enable you to obey the Word. Your strength is in the Lord and in the Power of His Might not in yourself.
- 8. You have to cooperate with the Holy Spirit and be willing to be a doer of the Word.
- 9. Your Vertical Relationship is strengthened each day as you continue to draw closer to God. (Jeremiah 29:11-14; James 4:8)
- 10. If you are willing and obedient, God has promised that you will receive the benefits of that obedience. (Isaiah 1:9)
